

Alternator Replacement Instructions

- Remove the negative battery terminal from the battery and secure it out of the way, ensuring that it doesn't accidently make contact with the negative terminal.
- 2. Loosen the serpentine belt tensioner and remove the belt from the alternator pulley.
- 3. Remove the alternator's positive wire, and unclip the electrical connection.
- 4. Remove the bolts securing the alternator to the alternator bracket.
- 5. Remove the alternator from the vehicle. **Note: In some cases it may be necessary to loosen/remove components in order to remove the alternator from the vehicle.
- 6. Once the alternator is removed from the vehicle, measure the pulley diameter to ensure it matches the replacement alternator's pulley. If it does not, swap the pulleys.
- Reinstall in reverse order, once installed, confirm the vehicle is charging using a multi-meter or your vehicles gauge.
