2011-14 Mustang GT5.0 Off-Road H-Pipe

Removal of Stock H-Pipe

1. Loosen both OEM band clamps at the H Pipe outlet. Lift the lock tab to slide the band clamp rearward and disconnect the H pipe from the over axle pipes. Do not discard these clamps.

2. Unplug both rear O2 Sensors from the electrical harness located on each side of the transmission. Unscrew sensors from the OEM H pipe and set aside. These will be reused. **Refer to Figure 1**.

3. Remove the 4 M10 nuts and remove the OEM H Pipe from the car. NOTE: Access to the outer passenger side nut is from above, through the engine compartment. Remove the OEM gaskets and set aside. These will be reused. **Refer to Figure 2.**

1. Loosely install the Driver Side Front Section and Passenger Side Front Section using the supplied M10 Bolts, Flat washers, Lock washers, and M10 Nuts. Be sure to reinstall the OEM gaskets previously removed. Refer to Figure 3.

2. Install both the **Driver Side Rear Section** and **Passenger Side Rear Section** onto the Front Sections. Be sure the expanded portion of the 2.25" Crossover Pipe is on the driver side of the car and that the appropriate clamps have been loosely installed. **Refer to Figure 4.**

3. Reinstall the 2 Rear O2 Sensors previously removed into the **Driver Side Front Section** and **Passenger Side Front Section**. Reconnect to the wiring harness.

4. Continue the installation of your MBRP Cat Back Exhaust Kit as show in the Instruction Sheet supplied in the kit.

5. Adjust the system to provide clearance between all other under body components and hoses while ensuring the Tips are centered in the rear Fascia. Tighten all clamps once properly adjusted.
