TOOLS AND SUPPLIES REQUIRED

• Floor jack

- Jack stands (4 required)
- Drill and bits

- Wrenches, ratchets & SAE socket set
- Blue Loctite™

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Lift and support vehicle on a solid surface. Keep the vehicle weight on the suspension as it would be the ground. A drive-on lift is best but careful use of wheel stands or jack stands work well.
- 2. Remove the four rear k-member bolts from the chassis.
- 3. Slip the QA1 k-member brace into place with the forward extensions above the k-member and aligned to lower control arm support plate. Using supplied 10mm bolts and washers bolt the k-member brace into place. Mark the hole location of the front support plate holes in the lower control arm.
- 4. Remove the k-member brace and drill the holes that were marked in step 3.
- 5. Replace the k-member brace with all the bolts, washers, and nuts supplied in the kit. Use Blue Loctite™ on clean threads of the bolts. Torque to factory specifications on the k-member bolts and to 35 ft./lbs. for the 3/8" hardware.
- 6. Drive the vehicle and check the torque of all mounting hardware.

Note: To further upgrade your suspension, use other QA1 suspension products such as coil overs, shocks, struts, springs, torque arms, panhard rods, subframe connectors, strut tower braces, rod ends, spherical bearings, etc. For more information, go to our website at WWW.QA1.NET
